SECTIONS OF THE LEGACY TRAIL TEMPORARILY CLOSING FOR UTILITIES WORK

Due to construction work, a section of the Legacy Trail will be closed **April 18**th – **22**nd, reopening **April 23**rd. The portion of the Legacy Trail closing includes from the North Creek Bridge area located at the yellow mile marker LT-7.55 (approximately 6/10 of a mile north of Osprey Junction Trailhead Park and 1 mile south of Central Sarasota Parkway). A utilities contractor will be connecting a water main for future community development. The project will require work in a limited space near the bridge with large equipment such as a back hoe, trucks, drilling equipment and sections of pipe. The force main pipe is located approximately 50 feet under the edge of the trail and will require removal of a cross section of Trail. Other areas of The Legacy Trail sections will remain open during the construction.

The community is asked to plan for alternate routes during this time. For more information, call the Sarasota County Contact Center at (941) 861-5000.



Plant Of The Month

LOROPETALUM (LOROPETALUM CHINENSE)

Loropetalum chinense, also called Chinese fringe flower, is a finely textured evergreen shrub that spreads as it grows with branches arranged in horizontal layers. When vertical stems are periodically removed loropetalum makes an effective large scale groundcover. The flowers are arranged in small clusters with each having 4 narrow strap-like petals that droop downward. Once becoming established in a well-drained, partially shaded location, this pretty pink plant is very hardy for our area and can be considered drought tolerant


