

FLAG DAY – TUESDAY, JUNE 14th

People across the United States celebrate Flag Day on **June 14** each year, to honor the United States flag and to commemorate the flag's adoption. On June 14, 1777, the Continental Congress replaced the British symbols of the Grand Union flag with a new design featuring 13 white stars in a circle on a field of blue and 13 red and white stripes – one for each state. The number of stars increased as the new states entered the Union. The flag of the United States represents freedom and has been an enduring symbol of the country's ideals since its early days. Many people in the United States honor this day by displaying the American flag at homes and public buildings.



CULVERHOUSE COMMUNITY GARDEN

Many gardeners at Culverhouse Community Garden, located in the Culverhouse Nature Park, at the north end of the Legacy Bike Trail, are winding down as the rainy season approaches. Gardeners are busy harvesting the end of the spring crops which include: tomatoes, eggplant, melons, carrots, corn, cucumbers, peppers, pineapples, squash, sorrel, onions, okra, blackberries and beans – all organic! Some stalwarts will continue with summer plantings of okra, eggplant, sweet potato vines, purslane, and tropical greens to tide us over until the fall gardening.

The garden, in its fifth year of operation, is open to all Sarasota County residents. The garden has 75 plots under cultivation, over 100 members, a comprehensive composting system, an orchard, and several experimental plots.
