#### Birding on Palmer Ranch

This week's photo is of a Brown Thrasher seen visiting the grounds of *The Isles of Sarasota*.

The big, foxy-red Brown Thrasher is a familiar bird over much of the east. Sometimes it forages boldly on open lawns; more often it scoots into dense cover at any disturbance, hiding among the briar tangles and making loud crackling call notes. Although the species spends most of its time close to the ground, the male Brown Thrasher sometimes will deliver its rich, melodious song of doubled phrases from the top of a tall tree.

#### WATER COLOR PAINTING – SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 18<sup>th</sup> - 9:00am – 10:00am

This weekly program offers an opportunity for artists of all ages and skill levels to gather and paint with watercolors. Learn tips and tricks to creating watercolor masterpieces, or simply capture a beautiful winter morning in paint! Materials will be provided, though you are welcome to bring your own if you prefer. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult. Program takes place in the Nature Center. Space is limited to 10 people. Free plus camping or standard day park entrance fee. Donations for supplies greatly appreciated!

#### TRAM TOUR – SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 18<sup>TH</sup> - 1:30PM

Join knowledgeable and enthusiastic Park Rangers on a tram tour through the park trails to discover the secrets of Oscar Scherer State Park! Parking is available at the Nature Center and participants are asked to meet at the Nature Center promptly at 1:30 p.m. Seating on the tram is on a first-come, first-served basis, limited to 25 people. Make sure to arrive early to reserve the best seats - accommodations for two wheelchairs are also available. The cost to ride the tram is \$5.00/person, plus normal entrance fees. Children under 5 ride free with a paid adult.

#### GUIDED SCRUB WALK - SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 19<sup>th</sup> - 8:30AM

This weekly walk begins at the Nature Center and includes an informative walk through an ancient dune system. This unique habitat is home to the threatened Florida scrub-jay and a variety of plants and other animals. Space is limited to 15 people. There is no cost to participate other than normal park entrance fees for day-use visitors.

#### EAGLE VIEWING - SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 19<sup>TH</sup> - 9AM TO 11AM

This weekly program is offered during bald eagle nesting season. Two nests are located in the park, the easiest to access is on the Green Trail. Once nest construction has begun, part of the trails are roped off per federal law. To view the eagles from a safe distance, a volunteer will be manning a viewing station. A high-powered spotting scope to view the nest will be provided. The 20-minute walk to the eagle viewing station on the Green Trail from the Nature Center or campground is self-guided and trail maps can be obtained at the Ranger Station and Nature Center. There is no cost to participate other than normal park entrance fees for day-use visitors.

# BICYCLE SAFETY & COURTESY

#### **On The Legacy Trail**

- Pass in Single File
- Keep Right
- Don't Block the Trail
- Warn Before Passing
- Speed Limit 15 MPH
- · Cyclists Yield to All Others.
- No Pacing

# On Roadways: Did you know that a bicycle is legally defined as a vehicle in Florida? A cyclist:

- Must obey all traffic laws, signs, and signals.
- May not wear a headset, a headphone, or other listening device.
- Shall not ride more than two abreast except In bike lanes.
- Must indicate intention to turn with a hand signal.
- Shall not impede traffic when traveling at less than the normal speed of traffic when riding two abreast.

#### **Courteous Group Cycling includes:**

- Calling out and pointing out road hazards; holes, sticks, glass, etc.
- Indicating a change in position in the group.

Group cyclists are usually the most visible members of the cycling community.

The impressions that our actions leave on motorists we encounter have a tremendous effect on cycling advocacy.
