Birding on Palmer Ranch

This week's photos are of Limpkins, seen visiting the grounds of *Palmer Ranch*.

Looking like something between a Crane and a Rail, this odd wading bird has no close relatives. It is widespread in the American tropics, but enters our area only in Florida and southern Georgia -- only where it can satisfy its dietary requirement for fresh-water snail. Mostly solitary, Limpkins may be overlooked as they stalk about





in marshes and swamps; they draw attention with their piercing banshee wails, often heard at dawn or at night.

Sarasota County Planning and Development Services wants you to know that the property owner of the Palmer Ranch Development of Regional Impact (DRI) has applied for: 1) Application for Incremental Development Approval for Increment XXV of the Palmer Ranch DRI; and 2) Rezone Petition No. 16-32 to rezone approximately 21 acres from OUE (Open Use, Estate, 1 unit/5 acres) to RMF-3/PUD (Residential, Multi-Family, 13 units/acre/Planned Unit Development) zone district.
