## News You Can Use

### ROUNDAABOUT – HONORE AVENUE & BRIDGEHAMPTON BLVD.

You may have noticed site work taking place on the east side of Honore Avenue, across from the entrance to The Hamptons. This is a new Mattamy Homes development of single-family homes. For this new development, Sarasota County required the builder to provide the main entrance to this 412-home development, off of Honore Avenue, and directly across from the entrance to The Hamptons. The entrance is being provided in the form of a 2-lane roundabout, and will necessitate that Honore be moved to the east, so as to not affect the entrance to The Hamptons community. The cost of all construction, moving of utilities, landscape, etc. is being paid for, in full, by Mattamy Homes.

This week, we were advised by Mattamy that they had received our Right-of-Way Use Permit, and will begin construction shortly. Honore is not expected to be significantly impacted for another 4-6 weeks. Prior to the work on the roadway, you will see the required signage advising of the upcoming work.

The Master Association office, and the management of The Hamptons, are in communication with Mattamy, so that we can keep our members informed as to the progress of this project.

### HERON CLUB AT PRESTANCIA IS HOSTING AN ALZHEIMER'S SUPPORT GROUP

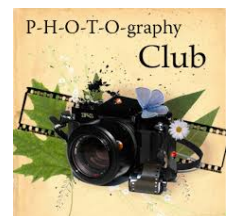
