News from the Friends of the Legacy Trail

Sarasota County acquired the next piece of land to extend the Legacy Trail toward downtown Sarasota, according to a recent press release. The Trust for Public Land purchased 2.7 miles of former railroad right of way with \$7.9 million approved by the county earlier this year. The money mostly comes from the county's Neighborhood Parkland Acquisition Program.

The land was purchased from CSX Transportation and Seminole Gulf Railway and extends from Culverhouse Nature Park in Palmer Ranch, the northern end of the Legacy Trail, to Ashton Road. With this purchase, Phase I of the Legacy Trail extension is complete. Phase II involves purchasing another segment of the trail, from Ashton Road to Fruitville Road, for \$30.1 million. This will require voters to approve the funding in a 2018 referendum to increase the property tax rate by 0.07 mills, or \$14 for \$200,000 of valuation per year for about 16 years.
