PALMER RANCH MASTER ASSOCIATION LAUNCHED BIRDING ON PALMER RANCH SEGMENT IN THE PALMER RANCH NEWSLETTER

We kicked off a new photo feature, *Birding on Palmer Ranch*. Featured each week was a photo and some facts about each bird.

This photo is of a Black Skimmer seen visiting the grounds of *The Glenridge on Palmer Ranch*. (*Photo credit: Fred Brisky*). The strange, uneven bill of the skimmer has a purpose: the bird flies low, with the long lower mandible plowing the water, snapping the bill shut when it contacts a fish. Strictly coastal in

most areas of North America, Black Skimmers are often seen resting on sandbars and beaches. Unlike most birds, their eyes have vertical pupils, narrowed to slits to cut the glare of water

and white sand. Flocks in flight may turn in unison, with synchronized beats of their long wings.



ARTISTS OF PALMER RANCH

We featured weekly articles on the Artists of Palmer Ranch. Getting their start all the way back in 1996, in the community of Huntington Pointe, six resident artists met in each other's homes to discuss and critique their art. The original group grew to include artists from other communities on the ranch and became officially established as the Artists of Palmer Ranch. Today, they're a group of thirty-six, meeting each month at the Gulf Gate Library, where they bring finished artwork or works in progress to discuss and show to fellow members. The variety of art is exciting to see! They have works in watercolor, oils, acrylic, wood sculpture, portraits, abstract and whimsical cartoon.




NATURAL ASSETS

FPL HARDENING PROJECT

Crews have been working on power poles along certain areas of Palmer Ranch throughout the year. This work is part of FPL's hardening project, which is said strengthen the main power line serving our area. Poles were replaced with stronger material and in some areas, poles are being added. Crews worked along Honore Avenue from Aviano Lane, north to Palmer Ranch Parkway; east on Palmer Ranch

Parkway to McIntosh Road; McIntosh Road from Sarasota Square Boulevard, north to Palmer Ranch Parkway to Mira Lago Drive and Kingston Boulevard west to Beneva Road.

SARASOTA COUNTY ADDED SIGNAGE TO STOP SIGNS AT HONORE AND CEN-

TRAL SARASOTA PARKWAY

Signage was added to the new lighted stop signs on Central Sarasota Parkway, at the intersection / Honore Avenue.

INTERSECTION SIGNAL RESURFACING

On March 20th, work started on the resurfacing of traffic signals and pedestrian arms at the intersections of McIntosh / Sawyer Loop; McIntosh / Palmer Ranch Parkway West; McIntosh / Palmer Ranch Parkway East; Beneva Road / Palmer Ranch Parkway West; and Beneva Road / Sarasota Square Blvd. In addition to the above locations, the pedestrian arms were resurfaced at the intersection of Honore Avenue / Palmer Ranch Parkway East.

CENTRAL SARASOTA PKWY AT HONORE ROUNDABOUT

We were advised that construction on the Central Sarasota Parkway / Honore Avenue roundabout will begin sometime in January of 2018.

HONORE AT BRIDGEHAMPTON / HONORE ROUNDABOUT

We were advised that construction on this roundabout is scheduled for December 2017.



HURRICANE IRMA

This hurricane season was one for the record books. The first major hurricane to make landfall in Florida since 2005, Hurricane Irma left behind downed trees & debris throughout Palmer Ranch.
