This coming week, workers will be preparing the landscape beds along the west side of McIntosh Road followed immediately by the installation of irrigation. All this is done in preparation for the spectacular color burst of serpentine plantings of Helen Johnson Bougainvillea within areas of Cabbage Palms.
