SARASOTA COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE - WORKSHOPS CONTINUE



Cycle 7 of the Sarasota County Comprehensive Plan Update focuses on three main topics: Capital Improvements, Intergovernmental Coordination and Citizen Participation. The Capital Improvements Workshop, to be held on **Monday, September 28** will give a basic overview of the Capital Improvements Chapter with a focus on the facilities composing the funded and unfunded capital improvement components. This is the synergy section, as all three topic areas make the plan come to life. The purpose of the Capital Improvements Chapter is the “glue” of the Comprehensive Plan. It’s function is to tie the implementing goals, objectives, and policies of the Comprehensive Plan with the funded improvements to support them.
