



#### **Sue's Grounds Corner**



Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) is becoming one of the most important emergency response programs in the area. With more and more people moving into the area, it's becoming critical that we have residents that can help Sarasota County Emergency Services during times of disastrous weather events. During times of disaster, Emergency Services personnel will not always be able to help everyone at the same time, CERT can make a difference by being first on the scene in your community. CERT is about "neighbors helping neighbors" and doing the greatest good for the greatest number. With CERT training, volunteers can provide basic medical aid, treat the life-threatening emergencies by opening airways, controlling bleeding, shock treatment, splinting, using a fire extinguisher, turning off electric/gas, searching & rescue until EMT's arrive and addressing the needs of survivors.

There are a number of communities within Palmer Ranch that have viable CERT programs already in place. There are also communities that don't have CERT programs established. If you live in Cobblestone, Deer Creek, Esplanade, Hammock Preserve, Huntington Pointe, Isles of Sarasota, Turtle Rock and VillageWalk, CONGRATULATIONS, you live in a community that has a well-managed and well-trained CERT team in place. Contact your Team and join with them to help.

### If you live in any of the other communities, take the steps to start a CERT team.

As an added incentive, the Palmer Ranch Master Association Board of Trustees wants to encourage community members to begin a CERT team by reimbursing the cost of a CERT Kit. Palmer Ranch will provide up to \$1,500 each year to provide "CERT Kits" to members of the Palmer Ranch community who complete the CERT training.

The first step in forming a team is to investigate what CERT is. Sarasota County maintains a website that shares information about everything CERT (<a href="https://www.scgov.net/government/emergency-services/community-emergency-response-teams-cert">https://www.scgov.net/government/emergency-services/community-emergency-response-teams-cert</a>). If you decide to form a team in your community, contact the CERT Program Manager for questions regarding CERT Programs and free training. Please call (941) 861-5000 to get connected. CERT is an excellent way to meet your neighbors if you are new to the area.
